**Additional Rules**

1. Owners and owners' agents are responsible for any errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class for which it is not eligible. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellations received after the close of entries, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge or barred from competition by the action of the committee. Telephone, Telegraph, Fax and unsigned entries cannot be accepted.
2. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the Show, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made.
3. This show will be unbenched. Exhibitors should bring their dogs to the show grounds one hour before the scheduled time of judging and may be excused after their class is judged, if they are not needed for further judging. Dogs MUST compete in every class in which they are entered or for which they become eligible.
4. Dogs must be ready for judging. Owners or owners' agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring at the proper time. The Club and/or the Show Secretary will not be responsible for and are not obligated to provide a service for notifying exhibitors of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for dogs holding up their rings.
5. The management will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dogs, on or off the show grounds, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is to be distinctly understood by all exhibitors that their dogs are to be in their custody and care at all times.
6. The Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
7. All grooming must be done in areas specified by the club and **exhibitors are required to keep their areas clean.**
8. Trophies and other Prizes will be awarded in the judging rings unless otherwise specified by the club. All claims for Trophies and other prizes must be made in the judging ring before completion of judging by the person handling the dog; such person shall be considered as the owner or owner's agent. The Secretary Office is to be notified at once in the event of any discrepancies. No trophies will be mailed.
9. Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under The American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts [AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows: Ch. 11, Sec. 11.] **PLEASE NO UNDERAGE PUPPIES. There are no provisions for dogs not entered.**
10. A recording fee of 50 cents will be required for each dog at any licensed or member club show, obedience trial or tracking test and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee. This recording fee and Event Service Fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class at a show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. AKC Rule, Ch. 11, Section 2.
11. The Show Giving Club, Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to any children.
12. Show Giving Club requires that "Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations and have proof of rabies vaccination.

### Best of Breed

**BEST OF BREED COMPETITION** - The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of record, which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championship is unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If, at the end of the 90 days period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by The American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed Competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC.

AKC" \*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that "Neutered dogs and spayed bitches would be allowed to compete in the Veteran Classes only at independent specialties and/or all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed.

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## Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries Show #2 & #4

**Stud Dog Class** - For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class. No dogs or bitches will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class. Fee is \$10.00 per get and stud dog.

**Brood Bitch Class** - For bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not be the owner of the produce. No dogs or bitches will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with her produce and be entered in the Brood Bitch Class. Fee is \$10.00 per produce and brood bitch.

The entry must also be

entered in one of the regular classes at the regular fee. The sweepstakes classes will be judged separately from the regular classes and might not be judged by an AKC licensed judge. The sweepstakes classes are divided as follows.

### Junior Showmanship Show #2 & #4

**Novice Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.



**Novice Intermediate Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Senior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Junior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

**Open Intermediate Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

**Open Senior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

**Master Class:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year. Junior handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Secretary or Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled Start of any regular conformation judging or one half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

**Notice:**

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your Junior Identification number by calling AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 816-3776. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

★ A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition counts as one win towards moving to Open. NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. ## **GROOMING SET UP AND PARKING!**

**THROUGH THE GENEROSITY OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, and THE TIMBER LINN MEMORIAL PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD,** we are pleased to offer a variety of parking options during the days of our specialty shows. These changes will help keep our animals and exhibitors more comfortable, and provide a safer venue in which to enjoy our sport. *Some changes in your traditional routine may be required as we move to make the specialty weekend better for all concerned.*

**Day parking in the gravel parking lot will be available at NO CHARGE, as usual.** We MAY be able to allow drive-in load / un-load ability; however, it is **NOT guaranteed**. It MAY be necessary for you to unload in the parking lot and transfer your equipment up to the show site. Come prepared, please. THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS ARE AVAILABLE:

- **FREE GROOMING SET-UP** will remain available, as always, in the big grassy area just South and East of the rings – on the West side of the walkway. Individual Pop-Ups etc. are welcome as always. Exhibitors are required to leave their area clean, especially be aware that dog hair clogs the mowers.
- Our Park Deposits and your entry eligibility depends on your leaving your spot pristine.

- **LIMITED OVERNIGHT RV PARKING in the LOT - \$10 / NIGHT:** NO POWER  
RESERVATIONS are REQUIRED; however, parking will be in line and on a first come / first serve basis.
- **RESERVED RINGSIDE PARKING.** A **limited** number of 10' x 40' spots, **with electrical hook-ups for CAR/VANS**, will be available for **DAY PARKING** on the far side of the paved walkway ONLY. This is the walkway that runs north and south just east side of the ring set-up. **NO SET-UPS will be allowed in this area without a PERMIT.**

**No overnight stays are allowed in this area;** ONE vehicle PER SPOT and all vehicles must vacate the premises by 10:00 PM each night;  
however, you may leave your pens, etc. set up and utilize the same space each day  
Cost is **\$50 / All Weekend**

**ALL RESERVATIONS MUST BE MADE THRU THE PARKING CHAIR.**  
**NO PHONE OR EMAIL RESERVATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

**Reservations received without payment will not be processed. Be sure to provide a VALID E-MAIL ADDRESS.**  
**Once your reservation has been processed, you will receive further instructions for CHECK-IN procedures.**

Special Requests of a minimal nature will be considered; however, ALL communication regarding parking **MUST** be directed to the **Parking Committee**, and *their decision is final*. Under no circumstance should the Timber-Linn Memorial Park office be contacted with questions or requests. Doing so may result in revocation of your entry privileges at this show.

By requesting parking during this venue, you stipulate to having read and agreed to all terms listed as imposed by the City of Albany, the Timber Linn Memorial Park and the clubs sponsoring these specialties.

- **OVERNIGHT RV PARKING – WITH POWER - \$100 / WEEKEND;**
- DAILY or PARTIAL reservations are available; *you must pay for weekend regardless of your arrival/departure day.*
  - a. ***Space is limited to the FIRST 8 PAID RESERVATIONS***
    - ***Parking without benefit of a reservation is subject to availability and allowed ONLY if arrival is prior to one***
    - ***hour before the posted start ON THE FIRST DAY. The fee will be \$125 at the gate – CASH ONLY.***
  - b. Spaces will be assigned based on the order received and size of the vehicle
  - c. Overnight spaces will be APPROXIMATELY 25' X 40', but may be irregularly shaped or sized to suit your RV size. Your tow vehicle must be parked within your allotted space.
  - d. **One** RIG / VAN / RV unit per space. If you have a second vehicle, or a friend joining you, they **MUST** reserve their own spot or park excess vehicles in the gravel lot.
  - e. Anyone wishing to be set-up together must be submitted in the same envelope.

Additional Regulations:

1. You must supply your own HEAVY DUTY electrical extension cord and appropriate adapters / surge protection.
2. You will be advised of your assigned electrical hook-up location by the **Parking staff in charge**. Connecting to any other source may result in the loss of your electrical privileges. No refunds will be made in such cases. NO CORDS of any kind may cross established pathways.
3. ALL overnight rigs must be **fully self-contained**.

### Pee Wee Class

- Pee Wee Class is a pre-junior showmanship class for children who are at least age 5 and under age 9 years on the date of the show.
- Dog must be at least four (4) months of age to enter and be handled
- All dogs must have proper leash and collar
- Entry Fee: \$5.00
- Judge: Diane Kröll
- Judging after Puppy/Veteran Sweepstakes and before Regular Breed Classes on **Saturday, July 16, 2022 - SHOW #1**
- Participation rosette for each junior.

This is not a competition, but rather a fun and educational learning experience. Each child is accompanied into the ring by a responsible adult who stays with the child always; only one Pee Wee Handler and one adult will be in the ring at any one time.

The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside the ring as well as ensure control inside the ring. A primary goal is safety and a positive experience for the children, so at the judge's discretion, the adult may be required to attach a second leash to the dog in the ring. A dog demonstrating any aggressive behavior will be asked to leave the show grounds. Eligible dogs include AKC recognized breeds, Miscellaneous/FSS breeds, dogs with a PAL/ILP listing, and All-American dogs. Bitches in season are not allowed to participate (eligible dogs may be substituted). Dogs must have a proper leash and collar. An AKC licensed junior showmanship judge will be officiating at this event.

All Pee Wee participants must sign and return a "Release of Liability" form signed by a parent or guardian before they will be allowed to enter the show ring.

The [Pee Wee Release of Liability](#) must be completed. These forms can also be picked up and completed ringside. You do not need a junior showmanship number to participate.
